

Comic-Con Prague 2021 revealed the names of more star guests: Neal McDonough, Edward James Olmos, Hugh Quarshie, and Cara Buono

Prague, 14th December 2020 – The organisers of Comic-Con Prague 2021 have revealed the names of more star attendees, including film stars Neal McDonough, Edward James Olmos, Hugh Quarshie, Cara Buono, and comic book creator Francesco Gerbino. The sale of photographs and guest autographs has also begun on the event's online store. The second Comic-Con Prague will take place from the 12th-14th February in Prague's O2 universum.

Comic-Con is a popular festival worldwide. It focuses on films, TV shows, games, comics, and books, which are predominantly in the sci-fi, fantasy, and horror genres. At each event, visitors can meet an unprecedented number of actors, comic creators, writers, and other artists. Among star guests at Comic-Con Prague, we can find director and producer Edward James Olmos. Edward is mostly known for his work on films such as *Battlestar Galactica* and *Blade Runner*, or TV shows such as *Agents of S.H.I.E.L.D.*, *Dexter*, and *Miami Vice*. Comic-Con Prague 2021 will also be attended by Hugh Quarshie, who is best-known for his roles in *Star Wars: Episode I – The Phantom Menace* and *Highlander*. Actor Neil McDonough will also be making his way to Prague for Comic-Con in 2021. Fans recognise Neil mostly thanks to his roles in the films *Star Trek VII: First Contact*, *Marvel One-Shot: Agent Carter*, or *Batman: Attack on Arkham*. Organisers have confirmed Cary Buono among on the list of attendees. Cary plays the role of Karen Wheeler in the TV show *Stranger Things* or Kelli Moltisanti in the TV show *The Sopranos*. Finally, comic creator and graphic designer Francesco Gerbino will be coming to Comic-Con Prague 2021. Francesco currently works with *Forced Perspective Comics* and his illustrations can be found on *Sky Network*.

Tickets to Comic-Con Prague can be purchased through Ticketmaster. The price of the ticket includes access to 16 rooms and stages, as well as every Q & A Session with star guests. As well as this, fans can also additionally purchase a unique experience with their favourite film stars. All it takes is that they check the event website to see when star guests are available for photographs, autographs, or signed studio photos, and then reserve a time slot. Guests can then make their way down to the designated area to get their photograph, autograph or studio photo. In doing so, they will also have a wonderful experience with their favourite star. Autographs and photographs are priced from 190 Kč, although this can change depending on the chosen guest.

„The second edition of Comic-Con Prague will definitely go ahead, because we do not want to let fans down by not putting on this event,“ explains Pavel Renčín, Head of Marketing at Active Radio, whose production division *No Limits* is jointly organising the event. „Of course we acknowledge the severity of the current situation, which is why we are also working with the possibility of organising the event on alternative dates. Should it be necessary, we will move the event to May,“ Renčín adds.

Active Radio a.s.

Active Radio is a multimedia group, which owns the radio stations Evropa 2, Frekvence 1, Radio Bonton, Dance radio, Youradio, and Youradio Talk. It is also responsible for the children's project, PiGy. Active Radio runs a number of online media outlets, streaming radio services, and it connects fans via social media and through organising events. The company's NoLimits division organises events for more than 100 000 people. Since 2018, Active Radio forms a part of the Czech Media Invest holding group.

Comic-Con Prague s.r.o.

In order to organise Comic-Con Prague, Václav Pravda created a new private limited company. This new company works closely with SFK Avalon o.s., which is a non-profit organisation run by fans. SFK Avalon is responsible for several huge pop culture festivals, including Festival fantazie (attended by up to 3500 fans, and in 2020 it celebrated its 25th anniversary in Chotěboř), PragoFFest (attended by 4500 fans, and its 10th and final installment took place in 2019), FanCity (attended by 2500 people in Prague, but now it is a smaller con in Chotěboř), and GameFFest (the gaming section of all of the aforementioned festivals).
